It's Canning Time ...

Change for Children's Final Push

hildren's Homes, Inc.'s annual Change for Children campaign is in its final stages for 2021. This year's campaign has gone more normal than the 2020 campaign. Most churches didn't even have the opportunity to get coinbanks distributed to their members before they had to discontinue in-person services for several

months due to COVID-19.

Even with churches meeting in person again and being able to distribute the coinbanks, this year's campaign hasn't been as robust as we had hoped. As of

Oct. 4th, the Change for Children campaign total only stood at \$176,000, which is well-short of our normal totals of up to \$350,000 and a very far cry from last year's recordsetting \$440,000.

We know there are many factors that play into the success of this annual campaign. Probably the biggest uncontrollable factor is how people don't have a lot of change any longer. With people moving toward the use of debit and credit cards for their purchases, they don't have as much change to put into a coinbank.

Another factor is many people aren't carrying cash or writing checks near as much since the use of debit and credit cards has become the preferred method of payment.



We are trying to combat these two factors by using a round-up giving program to re-capture the pocket change. This giving program can be signed up for by texting "Change4Children" to 43506 or clicking on the "Round-Up" link in the bottom right corner of our website (www. childrenshomes.org).

NOTE: To be able to participate in the round-up giving program, the user must already be accessing the online account information of the debit or credit card they want to register.

Once you have registered your card, you can set your round-up limit for the month. My round-up limit is \$50 per month. Every purchase made with my registered card is rounded up to the next dollar. Once I hit the \$50 limit, purchases will not be rounded-up again until the beginning of the next month.

At the end of each month, those using the round-up giving program will get a message that includes how much rounded-up change was donated to Children's Homes, Inc. on their behalf.

Obviously, the round-up program is an easier way to give to the campaign over actually filling a coinbank with pocket change. But, please don't think for a moment we don't want those filled coinbanks. We still want those coinbanks. As a matter of fact, I've been traveling around to many places collecting those filled coinbanks from congregations and individuals who didn't get to bring them to us due to us having to cancel this year's Homecoming and Fish Fry at the end of September.

The commitment to this annual campaign runs deep for many people, and those people have passed down this commitment to the generations who follow them.

On August 4th of this year, Ardith Neal Wagley passed away. In his obituary, the family suggested memorial gifts be made to Children's Homes, Inc. due to his ongoing support and love for the work here, which was demonstrated by his personal commitment to donate all of his pocket change combined with a greater annual donation to support this ministry.

In the spirit of his commitment, the family encouraged people who came to the visitation and funeral to bring their pocket change. The Wagley family planned to match whatever change was given as a memorial gift honoring Neal. Neal's commitment to this annual campaign was evident to his family.

As we near the end of 2021, I pray you will help us push our annual Change for Children campaign closer to our normal results.

If you have filled coinbanks that need to be picked up, please get them to your congregation and have someone contact us about coming to get those coinbanks.

Whether you fill a coinbank, write a check or participate in the round-up giving program, please know we appreciate your continued commitment to this campaign.

The funds raised through Change for Children help provide a Christian, familyfocused environment for God's children to overcome their pasts and prepare for their futures. They help provide quality houseparents, teachers, caseworkers, foster parents and support staff to guide the children through life's challenges. They help provide necessary programs used to educate and equip the children for life back home with their families or life on their own. Most importantly, the funds help keep Children's Homes, Inc. from ever having to use government funding, thus allowing us to protect our freedoms to worship and teach God in every aspect of this ministry.

Your continued commitment to the ministry at Children's Homes, Inc. encourages all of us. It gives us the motivation to keep on keeping on for the sake of God, His children and their families. Thank you for being a part of the CHI Family.

DONORS ANSWER CALL FOR HELP WITH EQUINE PROGRAM

rince. Checkers. Dancing Jerry. These are names of horses that bring a smile to the face — and maybe the occasional twinge of a memory of frustration — at their very mention around our former students. We have been blessed with so many gentle, good horses over the years to keep our equine program rolling, but as all animals do, our horses age and reach a point where they can't participate in the exercises in the program as much.

We put a call for assistance to our supporters who own horses to see if we could replenish our lineup. Our supporters answered in a big way. We've added five horses to the program in the last year, and their names are already beginning to take root in our

students' minds, preparing to bring up the same kind of fond memories our older horses' names do for our former students.

There's Carlot, Smokey, Hannah Storm, Cash and Lady. All of them became popular with our students almost instantly. And they all get a moment or two to shine in the photos of our upcoming 2022 calendar, which takes a deep look at our student's thoughts on our most popular programs.

"They are fitting in real well," Equine instructor Brian Rankin said. "They're learning what they need to do. They've become more people friendly. They're listening a lot better. They are more responsive to the kids than they were when they first came. They're calmer and standing still better — most of them."

Lady has emerged as a crowd favorite of the new additions so far.

"As a whole, the kids want Lady more than anyone else," Brian said. "Lady has her quirks but she is very gentle with the kids. She's uncooperative in some ways, but she's very gentle where the other ones — if you get in their space, they'll get you out of it. Lady is more accepting of the kids."

Carlot, that exception to the rule of the new horses getting calmer and more still, has presented a bit more of a challenge. But even a challenging horse can bring great benefit to the program.

"Carlot is full of energy," Brian said. "I think part of what he does is therapeutic. He knows what these kids need. It's like he's thinking, 'You're authoritative? You think you can make me do what you want me to do? OK. I'll show you.' or 'You don't have very good boundaries? I'm going to teach you what happens when you don't have good boundaries.' In that way, he definitely teaches the kids."

As they continue to progress, this group of newcomers looks to be a great addition, ensuring that this crucial program will thrive for some time.

"They are very responsive to the kids," Brian said.
"They protect the kids. They still have a long way to
go, but they are learning what the kids need and what
they need to do. I thank the donors very much for
contributing to the Equine program. These horses are
doing their job, treating the kids well and teaching
them the skills of life."

UNSUNG PROGRAMS

A LOOK AT CHI'S LESSER KNOWN ADAPT-TO-LIFE GROUPS

hen students are asked about their favorite group sessions or programs at Children's Homes, Inc., the answers are usually pretty close to the same. Everyone loves Equine. Some like Pathfinders. Entrepreneurship has some big fans. Low Ropes appeals to those who love a good challenge.

When we share photos online of Adapt-To-Life group activities, more often than not, the photos come from one of those programs. We just filled an entire calendar with photos and information about those groups.

The reason is simple. Those other groups have heavy activity whether working with horses or trekking through the wilderness or wiggling across a rope pretending tennis balls are some kind of rare egg.

Our other groups don't involve near as much physical activity. In fact, they are probably 95 percent talk. And as such, they aren't quite as photogenic, therefore they don't get a lot of social media attention when we do post about them.

But these other groups are every bit as crucial to a student's progress at Children's Homes, Inc. as the more popular programs because important concepts are being discussed.

The following is a rundown of those other groups provided by Paul Schandevel, CHI's Director of Child and Family Services:

Grief and Loss/New Beginnings

"In Grief and Loss, some of these kids are essentially orphans. They've lost biological parents. In some cases, the parents have divorced. Or the dad and mom never married. Or either the mom or dad abandoned the kid due to drugs. So there's a lot of grief issues they have to work through. Grief is prevailing. Some have said that grief is the bedrock of why people have mental health issues because they can't get over significant losses."

"New Beginnings is basic life skills. It also provides a purpose for why the kids exist. It gives them context as to

why they are even here on earth. We teach them God's creation. The material we use started off as a curriculum for prisoners written by a Christian. He used it to help prisoners understand the meaning of life and give them the common sense reason for why we're here. We didn't come from amoeba. We didn't just burst out of the Big Bang."

Processing Group

"Thursday's group is all about goals they have set in the Balcom Learning Center. They work daily to collect evidence to show to their peers and our staff to prove they are working on improving. Once they accomplish their second goal, they're usually able to move on to regular school."

Working Together

"It's eight Saturdays a year. Once a month during the school year and once during the summer, families come to experiential group where the parents are taught to understand their family Working Together."

as a living organism —as a system. We teach them how to manage that system. We teach them 16 basic skills. The point is to show the parents that as you raise your family you have to use these skills often. So they'll have them in their quiver when they need it. The kids fare campus and we put them through this much better in our program when their families are working with us in Working Together. We wouldn't see the progress we see without

ccording to National Philanthropic Trust, 69 percent of all charitable gifts in 2020

were from individuals. In 2020 six out of ten (or 60 percent) of American households

participated in some sort of charitable giving, according to The Philanthropy Roundtable. We are a generous country.

Giving to charity can be very satisfying when it compliments your goals. Fortunately, there are many options to choose from when you are considering making a charitable gift. Here are eight of the most popular methods to use:

1. Cash

The most familiar type of gift is cash. Nonprofit organizations are pleased to accept checks or cash in any amount. Outright gifts of cash are fully deductible for federal income-tax purposes. When you make a charitable contribution of cash to a qualifying public charity, in 2021, under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, you can deduct up to 100 percent of your adjusted gross income.

2. Securities

Nonprofits accept gifts of publicly traded stocks, bonds, and mutual funds at fair-market value. Fair-market value is determined under IRS rules.

A gift of appreciated stock held by a donor for more than a year offers the donor a three-fold tax savings. First, the donor avoids paying any long-term capital gains tax on the increase in value of the stock. Second, the donor receives an income tax deduction for the full fair-market value of the stock on the date of the gift. Finally, the stock will not be included in the donor's estate upon the donor's death.

3. Real Estate

Whether it's the family home, undeveloped land, or rental property, your real estate held for more than one year may be the most highly appreciated asset you own. This means you could face significant capital gains taxes if you sell your real estate. Donating real estate to a 501(c)(3) public charity could allow you to leverage one of your most valuable investments to achieve maximum impact with your charitable giving.

When an individual makes an outright gift of real estate to an organization, the donor can take a charitable deduction of the fair-market value of the property contributed. In addition, the donor avoids capital gains tax

on the profit that would have been taxable if the property had been sold and then donated to charity, which may

increase the amount for charity by up to 20 percent. Finally, the asset will not be subject to estate tax at the time of the donor's death.



4. CGAs

With charitable gift annuities, donors give an irrevocable gift of cash or securities to a nonprofit in exchange

for a fixed income payment for a set term or for life. The donor can take an immediate tax deduction while the nonprofit can invest and grow the funds. When the donor passes or the annuity term is up, the nonprofit keeps the leftover funds. Some choose to defer their annuity payments until they retire, resulting in higher payments.

Charitable gift annuities are a good giving option for donors who want to make a gift while still protecting their income. This is a good way to enjoy a yearly income while still making a significant impact on a cause you care about.

5. Retirement Plan Assets

Using IRAs and other retirement plan assets is a far-sighted and thoughtful way to make a charitable contribution. It provides a donor several significant financial and tax advantages. Unlike many assets, retirement plan assets are potentially subject to both income and estate taxes. Naming a nonprofit as the beneficiary of a retirement plan (including IRAs, 401(k)s and profit-sharing plans) can eliminate estate and income taxes, if the gift is structured properly.

6. Charitable Trusts

When a donor contributes assets to a charitable trust, they then receive annual income based on a fixed percentage of either the annual fair market value of the trust or based on the amount of the initial assets used to fund the trust. At the end of the trust's term, the remaining balance goes to the nonprofit. These trusts usually give a donor an income for a term of up to 20 years or for life.

Charitable trusts are best for donors who want to make a gift while still enjoying an income from their assets or anyone who is subject to paying capital gains taxes on appreciated assets.

SAFE MINISTRY MINUTE

Church Security & Armed Security Guards

In the wake of the recent shootings at churches around the country, we urge all churches to have a violence response plan. Each church must determine whether its circumstances merit an armed security team.

1. Create a Plan

No church is immune from being a target. Yours could be chosen simply because it's a large place where people gather.

2. Experience & Training is Essential

If you don't know where to start, hire a security consultant to help you assess your ministry's security risks. Former law enforcement officers make excellent candidates for church security positions.

3. Consider These Factors:

- 1. Team Composition How will you screen your volunteers and professional security guards?
- 2. Risk to Others Could they be accused of using excessive force? How will they be supervised?
- 3. Training How much formal weapons training have security team members received?
- 4. Vocation Are security personnel current or former law enforcement agents?

7. Bequests by Will or Trust

Bequests are the most common form of deferred gifts, accounting for approximately 80% of all deferred gifts each year. Bequests are one of the simplest, most impactful, and popular ways to make a planned gift.

To make a charitable bequest, a donor allocates a portion of their estate to a nonprofit in their legal will. Assets can be allocated by, specifying an amount of cash (i.e., \$10,000), or a percentage of the total estate, or by a residual bequest. A residual bequest directs the remainder of the estate or a designated percentage of the remainder of the estate to charity, after all other provisions in the will or trust are satisfied and all estate administrative costs are paid.

8. Beneficiary Designation

If donating income earning assets is a concern, consider making a charitable gift via a beneficiary designation. You can designate charitable organizations as the beneficiary of all or a portion of various assets (i.e., retirement accounts, life insurance, annuities, etc.) at the time of your death. Such beneficiary designations are revocable. They may be changed at any time during your lifetime.

Donating from a tax-deferred retirement account is a tax advantage because charities do not pay income tax. This means the full amount of your donation will avoid income tax and directly benefit the charity of your choice. It's possible to divide your retirement assets between charities and heirs according to any

percentages you choose.

These are just a few ways you can receive tax breaks in exchange for your charitable gifts.
