'Never Forget Why You Do What You Do'

We all have people who walk into our lives and who make an impact so indelible that, when they pass away, you feel a little less complete. Floyd Daniel was one of those people in my life.

When I started working at Children's Homes, Inc. back in March of 2000, I quickly started hearing conversations about Floyd. I knew that he and his wife, Juanita, had been very hands-on in this ministry

serving as foster parents and generous supporters long before I came into the CHI family.

It didn't take long to fully understand just how important the Daniel family was to the history and success of Children's Homes, Inc. You see, they were not only foster parents and supporters, they were very vocal advocates to anyone who would listen.

Floyd was a senior vice president for Harding University. He loved Harding and spent many years traveling the country encouraging people to financially support the university. Right below his love for Harding was his love for Children's Homes, so much so, that he asked Dr. Cliff Ganus, longtime president of Harding, if it would be okay if he raised funds for both places in his travels.

He had a keen sense of people's values and could tell when someone cared about ministries that helped rescue God's children from places of abuse, neglect and abandonment. With Dr. Ganus' blessing, Floyd set out to find those people who would be willing to give to both Harding and Children's Homes. And he did just that through the years. He brought so many people into the CHI family. His passion was overwhelming to the point that people wanted to help just because HE believed in us.

Second to his ability to influence people to donate was his ability to tell a story. Floyd's stories were (and still are) legendary. They weren't just stories, they were stories with purpose. While it might take him a long time to get to the meat of the story, he always got there and when he did, you always had one of those "Wow!" moments.

Now, to be honest, his stories did go on...and on...and on, and it was hard to get away from him. If you knew Floyd, you are chuckling right now because you know what I am talking about...don't you? I will never forget sitting in his office one day on the campus of Harding University listening to his stories. It was on a Wednesday afternoon and I was needing to get back to Paragould for Bible study. He wrapped up a story and stood up from behind his desk. I thought we were ending our

visit, so I also stood only to hear him say, "Sit back down, Son. I just need to run to the restroom." While he was out of the office, I called my wife and said, "I won't make it back for Bible study. Floyd's not done yet. I'll be home when I can get there."

I have heard it jokingly said on more than one occasion that people finally gave just to get Floyd to stop telling stories.

Floyd was also an encourager. He loved to see people grow, and he loved to send them notes of encouragement. I have many handwritten letters from him. One of my most special letters is the one I received right before I stepped into the role of Executive Director at Children's Homes, Inc. It was a letter of belief and motivation, and he gave me his blessing.

Finally, Floyd was able to balance pride and humility beautifully. He was proud of his accomplishments in life and he would tell you about those accomplishments on occasion. However, he was never boastful, but helpful. He wanted people to find their potential in life just as he had found his. Floyd was successful, yet, in his success, he never really wanted any accolades.

Many years ago, Children's Homes built an equine therapy center at the Emmett Smith Memorial Farm. In appreciation of Floyd and Juanita's many years of support, we decided to name the building in their honor and had a bronze plaque crafted for the building. Shortly after the grand opening of the facility, Floyd asked if their names could be removed and if we would honor one of their foster children instead. Things were never about him. He was just a vessel God was using for good works.

When Juanita passed away in June of 2013, Floyd lost a bit of his zeal, as so many do when their spouse passes away. However, he never forgot his purpose. He continued to hit the road searching for people who shared his passion for children.

As the years passed after Juanita's death, Floyd had his own health issues. I knew something was changing the day I visited him in a rehabilitation center in Searcy. We had been visiting for about 30 minutes when he looked at me and asked, "What time is it, Son?" When I told him it was almost 11:30, he quickly said, "Gotta go! They are about to bring my lunch." And he got up and walked away. Prior to the affects of dementia starting to take hold of his mind, Floyd would have rather talked than eat any day.

Shortly after that visit, Floyd officially retired from Harding University and moved to Franklin, Tenn., to be closer to family. Like so many, Floyd's battle with dementia grew more difficult and on October 24th, 2019, he passed from this life.

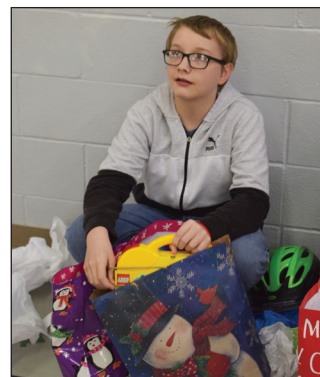
of crafts. Members of the Paragould campus' entrepreneurship group were also on hand to sell some of the items they have made.

Reason to Celebrate

CHANGE FOR CHILDREN CAMPAIGN SURPASSES 2019 GOAL

After three years of falling short of goals, the Children's Homes, Inc. Change for Children got back on track in a big way in 2019.

Following several years of declining results (mostly because change just isn't as prevalent as it once was) and slightly lowered goals, CHI set a goal of \$300,000 for the 2019 campaign. The estimated total (which will be verified soon) for last year was — allow us to pause briefly for suspense — \$349,831.40. That beats the 2018 total by more than \$100,000.

With the additional boost of the Round-Up option and a lot of support from our faithful coinbank collecting congregations, the campaign seems pointed in the right direction for 2020.

The Round-Up option allows our supporters to register a debit card or credit card (or both) and set a monthly round-up giving limit. Every time you make a purchase using whatever card you registered, your purchase amount will be rounded-up to the next dollar. That extra change will then be given to Children's Homes, Inc. at the end of each month.

There are two ways to sign up.

The first way is to go to our website (childrenshomes.org) and click on the "Round-Up" button in the lower right corner of the home screen. You can simply follow the prompts to register.

The second way to set-up an account is to text **Change4Children** to **43506**. You will receive a message

that includes a link. Click on the link and follow the prompts to register.

Keep in mind, we will still be distributing coinbanks. In fact, soon we will be ordering new coinbanks to coincide with the 2020 campaign (of course, we still accept any iteration of our coinbank). A tentative design for the new can appears above. So by midyear, these new coinbanks should be popping up at our supporting churches.

Does your church currently participate in our Change for Children campaign? Would you be willing to spearhead an effort at your congregation?

Retirement Accounts

THEY AIN'T WHAT THEY USED TO BE

The Setting Every Community Up for Retirement Enhancement (SECURE) Act of 2019, better known as the SECURE Act, which originally passed the House in July, was approved by the Senate on Dec. 19, 2019, and signed into law on Dec. 20 by President Donald Trump. The bill includes significant provisions aimed at increasing access to tax-advantaged accounts and preventing older Americans from outliving their assets.

There are a number of provisions in the act for the benefit of the everyday American. Here are a few you may be interested in:

1. You can make IRA contributions beyond age 70½

As Americans live longer, an increasing number are continuing to work past their traditional retirement age. Under the act, you can continue to contribute to your traditional IRA past age 70½ as long as you are still working and have earned income. That means the rules for traditional IRAs will align more closely with 401(k) plans and Roth IRAs.

2. Required minimum distributions (RMDs) now begin at age 72

This applies to individuals that have not attained age 70½ by December 31, 2019.

Americans are working longer and will no longer be required to withdraw assets from IRAs and 401(k)s at age 70½. RMDs now begin at age 72 for individuals who turn 70½ in the calendar year 2020. If you turned age 70½ in 2019 and have already begun taking your RMDs, you should continue to take your RMDs. The IRS may provide further guidance on this point, so you might want to speak with your tax advisor regarding any 2020 distributions.

If you are turning 70½ in 2020 and had planned on taking an RMD, you may want to work with your financial advisor to reconsider your withdrawal plans.

3. Inherited IRAs generally must now have all taxes paid within the first 10 years

Previously, if you inherited an IRA or 401(k), you could "stretch" your distributions and tax payments out over your

single life expectancy. Many people have used "stretch" IRAs and 401(k)s as reliable income sources.

Now, for IRAs inherited from original owners who have passed away on or after January 1, 2020, the new law requires many beneficiaries to withdraw assets from an inherited IRA or 401(k) plan within 10 years following the death of the account holder.

Exceptions to the 10-year rule include assets left to a surviving spouse, a minor child, a disabled or chronically ill beneficiary, and beneficiaries who are less than 10 years younger than the original IRA owner or 401(k) participant.

Many people have named a trust the beneficiary of their retirement accounts in order to regulate the payments heirs will receive over their lifetime from the retirement account. The SECURE Act no longer allows that since the only minimum distribution is the end of the tenth year – 100 percent of the account would come out and be taxed at that point. All inherited funds would be released to the beneficiaries, abolishing what the account owner wanted.

With that in mind, you should talk with your estate planner or financial advisor about setting up a charitable remainder trust, upon your death, to meter out payments to heirs over many years thereafter.

If you're a beneficiary of an inherited IRA or 401(k) and the original owner passed away prior to January 1, 2020, you don't need to make any changes.

You should review the beneficiary designation on your retirement accounts to ensure your goals are still being met under the SECURE Act.

4. 529 funds can now be used to pay down student loan debt, up to \$10,000

Some families find they have money remaining in their college savings plans after their children graduate. Now, they can use a 529 savings account to pay up to \$10,000 in student debt over the course of the student's lifetime.

If your family's 529 plans have money left over after you pay for college expenses, consider using the remaining money to help pay off student loans.

SAFE MINISTRY MINUTE

9 KEY RISK AREAS CHURCHES FACE

Good risk management starts with asking tough questions about your ministry's practices and operations. Here are nine areas to consider when developing a risk management plan for your church:

Accident Prevention: Are your sidewalks well lighted, dry, and covered with non-slip material? Are walkways and doors kept free of obstructions? Are parking lots safe? Is playground equipment maintained?

Childcare: Do you use a paging or other system to ensure children return only to authorized parents? Do you do a background check on all of your workers and volunteers?

Fire Protection: Does your church have a fire alarm system and fire extinguishers readily available? Are your fire sprinklers maintained?

Transportation Dangers: Does your church own vehicles that are well maintained? Do you use volunteer drivers? Do they have adequate insurance? Are they trained to drive large vans or buses?

Counseling: Does your church (or the individual counselors) carry professional liability insurance? Do you have a policy that covers counseling activities?

Finances/Payroll: Are dual signatures required for all checks above small amounts? Are all church credit cards properly maintained and regularly checked? Are at least two people present when offerings are counted? Does your church file the appropriate tax forms for all employees, including W-2s and 1099s?

Volunteer Selection and Training: Does your church thoroughly screen volunteers who will be driving church vehicles or working with children? Do you supervise volunteers and train them in their responsibilities?

Security: Does your church have an electronic security system in place? Do you have a strictly enforced key monitoring system? Do you have adequate lighting around your doors, parking lots, and at the rear of your buildings?

Church Employees: Do you have up-to-date hiring policies? Do you provide ongoing training? Do you have a sexual harassment policy?

5. Transfers directly from your retirement account to charity are still allowed

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) are still allowed beginning at age 70 ½. This is a tax-efficient method of making charitable donations with funds from a Traditional IRA (or inherited Traditional IRA).

Essentially, an account holder (or beneficiary) age 70½ or older can transfer up to \$100,000 each year directly to charity. While the distribution from the account can count toward the account holder's annual Required Minimum Distribution, it is not included as Adjusted Gross Income (AGI), and thus does not need to (and cannot) be included as a charitable gift itemized deduction, making it

a 'perfect' pre-tax donation.

With the passage of the SECURE Act, however, IRA account owners must now reduce their intended QCDs by any contribution amounts made into their IRAs after age 70½ (the age cap in place to make IRA contributions before passage of the SECURE Act), to the extent they have not already been used to reduce their QCD. In other words, IRA contributions made after age 70½ cannot be turned around to be used as QCDs, and the rules effectively require a "Last In First Out" treatment that ensures contributions made after age 70½ will be used first to reduce future QCDs.

These are a few of the changes brought about by the SECURE Act. You should consult with your

tax advisor to see if any of these changes can benefit your situation, or if other changes not mentioned here can be of help.
